

ORDINANCE 6-17-2025

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE USE
OF ELECTRONIC VOTE COUNTING DEVICES**

WHEREAS, Chapter 7 of Title 17 of the *Code of Alabama* (1975), as amended, and the regulations adopted pursuant thereto by the Alabama Voting Committee provide for the use of Electronic Vote Counting Systems, and

WHEREAS, Section 17-7-21 of the *Code of Alabama* (1975), provides that a municipality may, in its discretion by adoption of an appropriate ordinance, authorize, adopt, and direct the use of electronic vote counting systems for use in all elections in such municipality.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Daleville, Alabama as follows:

Section 1. That for all elections held subsequent to the passage of this ordinance, the use of the DS200 ballot scanner/voting machine and ExpressVote Voter Assist Terminal, a system which complies with Section 17-7-21 of the *Code of Alabama* (1975) and regulations adopted pursuant thereto, is hereby authorized for the reporting, counting and tabulation of any and all election results.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of Daleville, Alabama is hereby authorized and directed to file a copy of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State as provided in Section 17-7-21, *Code of Alabama* (1975).


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication as provided by law.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALEVILLE,
ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. It is hereby established and declared that the following described real property of the City of Daleville, Alabama, is no longer needed for public or municipal purposes, to-wit:

Lots 37 and 38, Block B of Forest Park Subdivision, a subdivision of part of E1/2 of the Sw1/4 and part of the E1/2 of the S1/2 of the Nw1/4 of Section 31, Township 4 North, Range 24 East, as recorded in the Probate Office of Dale County, Alabama, in Plat Book 1 at page 195 of the Probate records of Dale County, Alabama


SECTION 2. That the mayor and the city clerk be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to execute and attest, respectively, for and on behalf of the City of Daleville, Alabama, a warranty deed, a copy of which is on file in the office of the city clerk, whereby the City of Daleville, Alabama, does convey the premises described in Section 1, hereof to John Marcus Grimes for and in consideration of the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00).
